3 KEYS TO A SOLID SHOT



KEY #2: CENTER FACE CONTACT - DRIVER

Center Face Contact with driver is especially important due to "Gear Effect." Because the driver head is larger than an iron, balls hit towards the toe will tend to HOOK and balls hit towards the heel will tend to SLICE. Hitting driver in the center of the face will allow us to produce straighter shots with more distance.

KEY #3: FACE PATH RELATIONSHIP

The CLUB FACE ANGLE determines the start direction of the golf ball. If the face is pointed left or right, hitting a straight shot will be challenging.

The SWING PATH determines which way the ball curves. We will discuss this in more detail in future sessions. The graphic on the right illustrates both the face and path.
