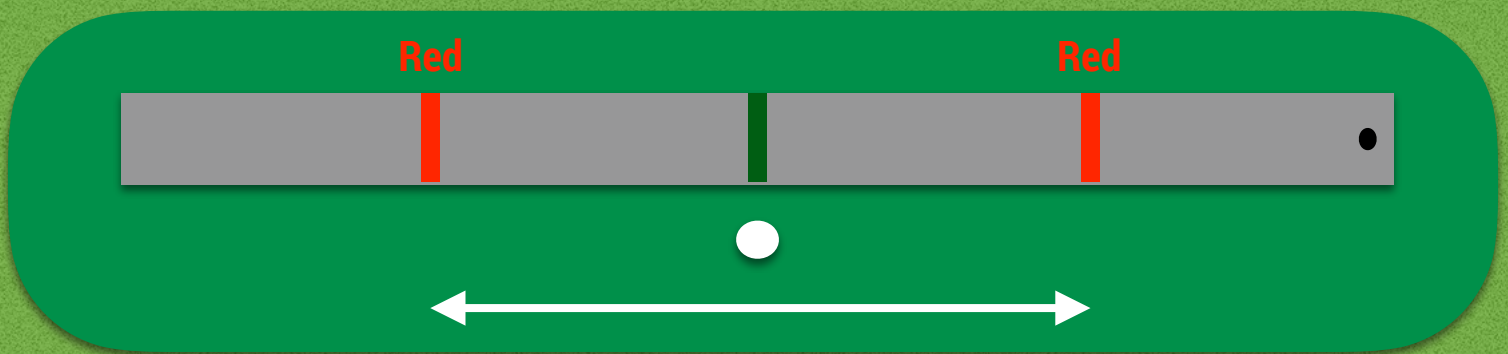


SMALL STOCK STROKE

Goal: Develop a foundational understanding of the two key concepts that determine speed when putting: **Size and Tempo**.

Place a ball at center of the ruler (white mark). The putter head should travel back and forth between the red marks for a **Small Stock Stroke**. If the *size and tempo* are similar for each stroke, the balls will stop in the Target Box.

If you miss the Target Box, think in terms of "Too big or too small" (size) or "Too fat or too slow." (Tempo)



Level 1: 3 out of 5 putts stop in the Target Box



Level 2: 4 out of 5 putts stop in the Target Box

Level 3: 5 out of 5 putts stop in the Target Box

Level 4: Place the ball on the green mark on the ruler.
4 out of 5 putts roll cleanly through the orange tee gate and
stop in the Target Box.
